The District Forest Officer, Territorial has  
discussed with me on 18.5.1992 in the light of reference 2nd  
cited above the matter pertaining to the cutting of trees in  
Chinthalapudi forest pursuant to the vacation of stay issued  
by the Government in respect of G.O. Ms. No. 185 dt. 9.7.1990.

1. The vacation of stay in respect of G.O. Ms.  
No. 185 dt. 9.7.1990 was effected on 16.12.1991. I recall that  
shortly afterwards most likely on 18th or 19th of December, 1991  
Sri T. Rama Reddy, M.L.A., Anaparthi visited my camp Office  
and gave me a copy of the vacation order. I recall passing  
on this order to the District Forest Officer Sri H. C. Mishra  
immediately thereafter for necessary action.

2. The District Forest Officer, Territorial has  
consulted me regarding the filing of prosecution against  
Sri Senkara Reddy, General Power of Attorney Holder for

felling of trees during the period 27.12.1991 to 4.1.1992. The matter was referred to the Assistant Government Pleader who opined that the fellings done during the currency of the stay vacation order dt. 16.12.1991 were covered by legal permission and no prosecution should stand in case such prosecution was initiated against Sri Sankara Reddy.

This is for favour of information and necessary action.
